4. Take a record vote on the District's 2026 tax rate, adopt an Order Levying Taxes, authorize filing the Order with the County Tax Assessor/Collector; and

6. Treasurer's Report, including but not limited to:
 - a. Discuss and consider action on bank statement review.
 - b. Status on Treasurer's Bond Application.
 - c. Discuss and consider action on paying district expenses and invoices, including:
 - Other invoices as presented.
7. Discuss and consider service provider contract renewals and/or amendments.
8. Review annual "To Do" list, assigning action for items that are coming due in the next few months, including:
 - a. Notify Wilco Tax collector of tax rate
 - b. Send approved budget, Resolution Adopting 2027 Budget and Order Levying Taxes
 - c. Send a copy of the budget to the city of Cedar Park
 - d. Calculate max bank account balance for next fiscal year: request bonding amount approval from judge and pass new number on to the insurance company
